

The tiny hands of class I got into various hands on activities during our online classes with zeal and fun.























Craft activities might get a little messy!



But preschool teaching is not just about performing various play way tasks according to a preset time table. It involves a lot of subjectivity. Teachers need to adapt to various innovative methods to make the young ones adapt and accept their new home.



Preschool is all about, guiding a bunch of youngling who are venturing out of their comfort zone for the first time, and teaching them the basic skills of life. *Not every child is similar, not every child requires the same amount of care.* On part of teachers, a lot of thought goes into dealing with every child and knowing how a child can evolve.

Young children are generally curious to learn about everything and share their knowledge of their findings. Motivating them and affirming their work would set their exploration on wheels. This motivates the child to gain mastery over their environment, promoting focus and concentration.

Children need to learn words to express themselves and understand instructions. They need to get a good grasp to hold ,catch, dress up and handle spoons and towel while eating. Teachers take an active role in guiding children's interactions in the play and support in developing social skills such as cooperation, sharing and responding to ideas and resolving conflicts. Some children find themselves overwhelmed by the norms in the classroom and find a niche of seclusion or throw tantrums. It requires lot of patience and skill to make every kid part of the classroom.

To say it metaphorically, Kindergarten is a root of a child's education. Their cognitive skills gets nourished, fine motor skills strengthened and social skills find deep paths to fix themselves

firmly to the true values of compassion, solidarity, patriotism, family, friendship and love towards fellow human being. It leads to great contentment while the tots merge into a responsible and contributing citizens for the community.


VIRTUAL MATH FEST-2020




How to Hydrate in Summer

One of the most common condition people suffer during summer is dehydration. Wherein body loses significant amount of water along with minerals and electrolytes. Rigorous exercise or any illness such as fever, loose motions or vomiting can aggravate dehydration, which can occur in people of all ages, but young children, babies and older adults are more The best way to stay hydrated is to drink plenty of water throughout the day, but this can also be substituted with coconut water, lemon water, fresh buttermilk, clear soup or fruit juices (without sugar) to keep up your electrolyte levels. Sweetened fruit juices and cold drinks should be avoided. Fruits and vegetables such as watermelon, cucumber, tomato, lettuce, oranges, grapes and banana are rich in water content, essential minerals and electrolytes. Consume them as much as you throughout the day for natural hydration. Additionally, avoid spicy, oily and pungent foods as they can increase acidity. If your skin is dehydrated, it can appear flaky, dull and dry. Hydrated skin is smooth, radiant and has an even tone. We have to keep our skin hydrated during summer.


The Dream Of The Chocolate Pudding




