(Sahih Hadith)

History Of Our School

The initial spark was lit by the Founder of Safa English School, Mumbai who motivated Janab Noorul Ameen Sahib to start a school here, supported by the initiatives taken by the trustees. The school was established and we succeeded in obtaining affiliation during the first year of commencement inspite of all odds and difficulties.

We were one of the first schools in Chennai to have signed up with XSEED, a proven and research based academic program for schools that builds thinking skills & problem solving confidence in primary school children.

As our school progressed and students completed their primary schooling, we realized the need to upgrade and obtain affiliation with CBSE at the earliest. It's a well known fact that CBSE ensures quality education and imposes many rules to be followed strictly by the schools, right from the infrastructure to qualified teaching staff to Effective teaching – learning methods in the classrooms. Our next milestone was moving into the new building at Zeenath campus in the year 2012 and the land was donated by Janab KA Wadood Sahib to further this noble cause. Another milestone has been the construction of a new building at Egmore in the year 2015 which lies in the heart of the city and caters to provide Quality education to Nursery and Primary school children..

Within a year, CBSE Affiliation was acquired and miraculously our first batch of students appeared for Class X Public Examination in the year 2015.

TRIP TO BIOTECH DEPARTMENT: UNIVERSITY OF MADRAS

The students of class 11 and 12 from the Science Department were taken on an Educational tour to University of Madras near Guindy on 7th of Sep 2017. The objective of this tour was to provide the students with an insight in the various techniques and procedures employed in the field of Biology. The students numbering around 35 along with 2 teachers, the principal and a helper departed from the school by 10:10 am and arrived at the University of Madras campus by 11:10am. First, the students were made to observe the instruments present in the Biochemistry Dept. like the UV spectroscopy device. Mr. Raja who works with the department explained about the Algae and Tissue culture, the PCR machine and other related techniques. Then the students headed to the Microbiology Dept. where Mr. Baskar who is a Ph.D student proved to be a helpful person and answered all the queries put by the students satisfactorily. He began by giving an introduction of Microbiology, the steps employed and the benefits it provides to humankind. The students were also shown bacterial and fungal cultures on culture plates. Then there was a short session on Bioinformatics. In this Department the students were told about the significance of Bioinformatics.

Next the students had an interactive session with a Ph.D scholar. She was an interesting and patient person who was kind enough to answer a range of doubts and questions from the importance of biotechnology to career scopes in various fields of Biology. She described some of the instruments like incubator and centrifuge and also introduced us to few higher devices like the chromatographic device. Lastly the students were taken to the Animal Biotechnology Dept. headed by Mr. Rajesh who showed us a culture of Spirulina using a light microscope. On the whole it was an Informative tour. Also, the facilities and the labs was a little ill-equipped, apart from that, the students got a general idea of things and were able to relate well to their theory classes.

THE MOST IMPORTANT SPEECH EVER MADE BY MAN ON EARTH

"O People, lend me an attentive ear, for I know not whether after this year, I shall ever be amongst you again. Therefore listen to what I am saying to you very carefully and TAKE THESE WORDS TO THOSE WHO COULD NOT BE PRESENT HERE TODAY.

O people, just as you regard this month, this day, this city as Sacred, so regard the life and property of every Muslim as a sacred trust. Return the goods entrusted to you to their rightful owners. Hurt no one so that no one may hurt you. Remember that you will indeed meet your LORD, and that HE will indeed reckon your deeds. ALLAH has forbidden you to take usury (interest), therefore all interest obligation shall henceforth be waived. Your capital, however, is yours to keep. You will neither inflict nor suffer any inequity. Allah has Judged that there shall be no interest and that all the interest due to Abbas ibn Abd Al-Muttalib (Prophet's uncle) shall henceforth be waived...

Beware of Satan, for the safety of your religion. He has lost all hope that he will ever be able to lead you astray in big things, so beware of following him in small things.

O people, it is true that you have certain rights with regard to your women, but they also have rights over you. Remember that you have taken them as your wives only under Allah's trust and with His permission. If they abide by your right then to them belongs the right to be fed and clothed in kindness. O PEOPLE, NO PROPHET OR APOSTLE WILL COME AFTER ME AND NO NEW FAITH WILL BE BORN. Reason well, therefore, O people, and understand words which I convey to you. I leave behind me two things, the QUR'AN and my example, the SUNNAH and if you follow these you will never go astray.

All those who listen to me shall pass on my words to others and those to others again; and may the last ones understand my words better than those who listen to me directly. Be my witness, O ALLAH, that I have conveyed your message to your people".

This sermon was delivered on the 9 th day of Dhul Hijjah 10 AH in the "Uranah valley" of Mount Arafat by the Prophet Mohammed ﷺ.

This ability cultivates an awe inspiring inner strength, we also need to build quiet-ego, and then we become less likely to act aggressively, manipulate others, express dishonesty and destroy resources. Instead we take responsibility for and correct our mistakes, listen to others' ideas and keep our abilities in humble perspective.

3. Express gratitude.
