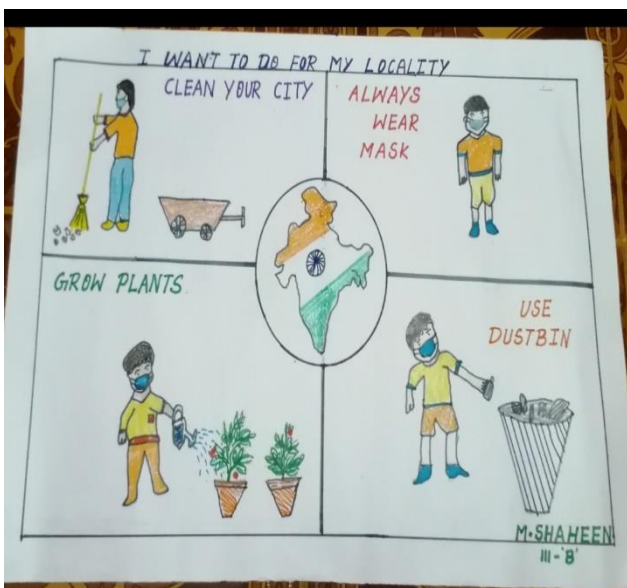
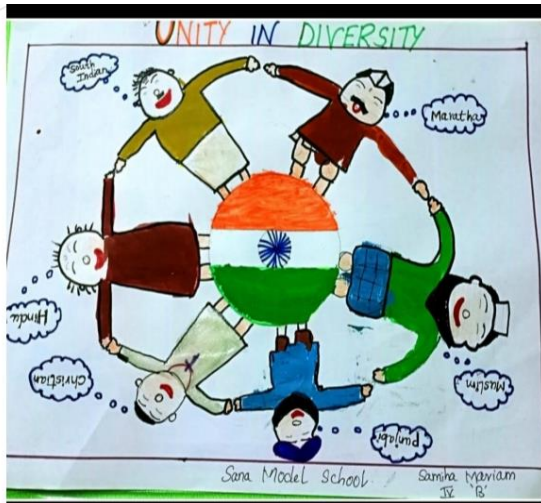


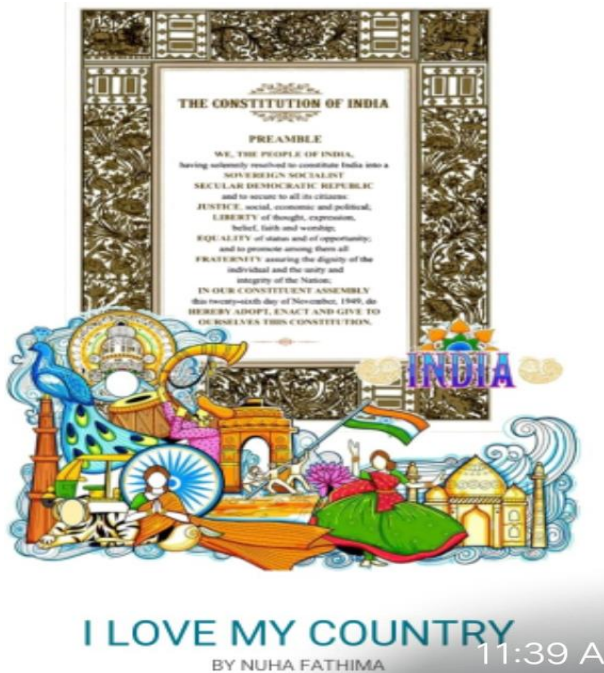
Our National Anthem, JANA GANA MANA, was composed originally in Bengali by Late Rabindranath Tagore.
