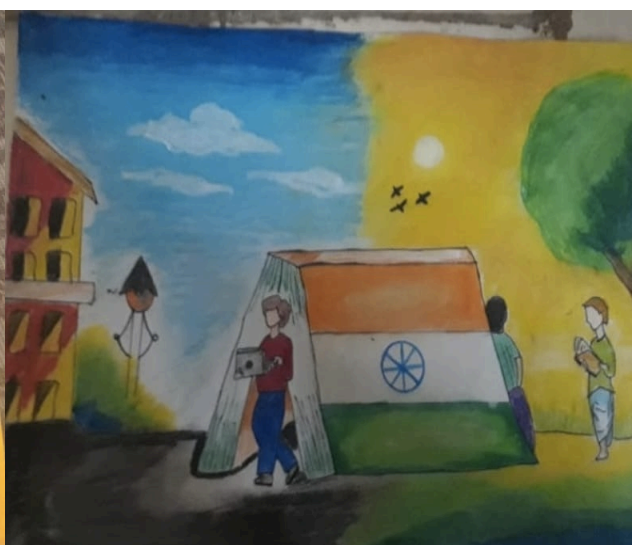

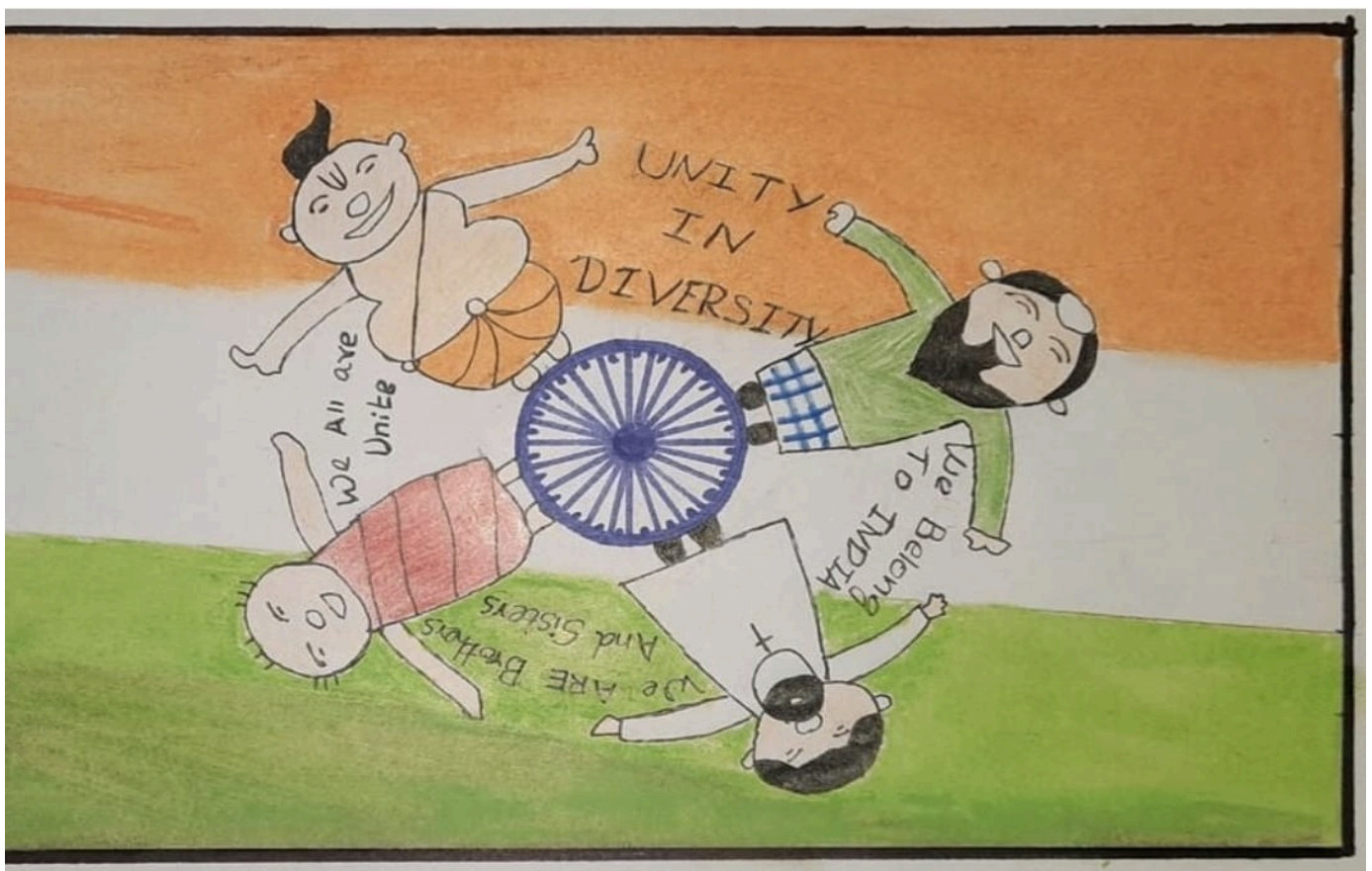

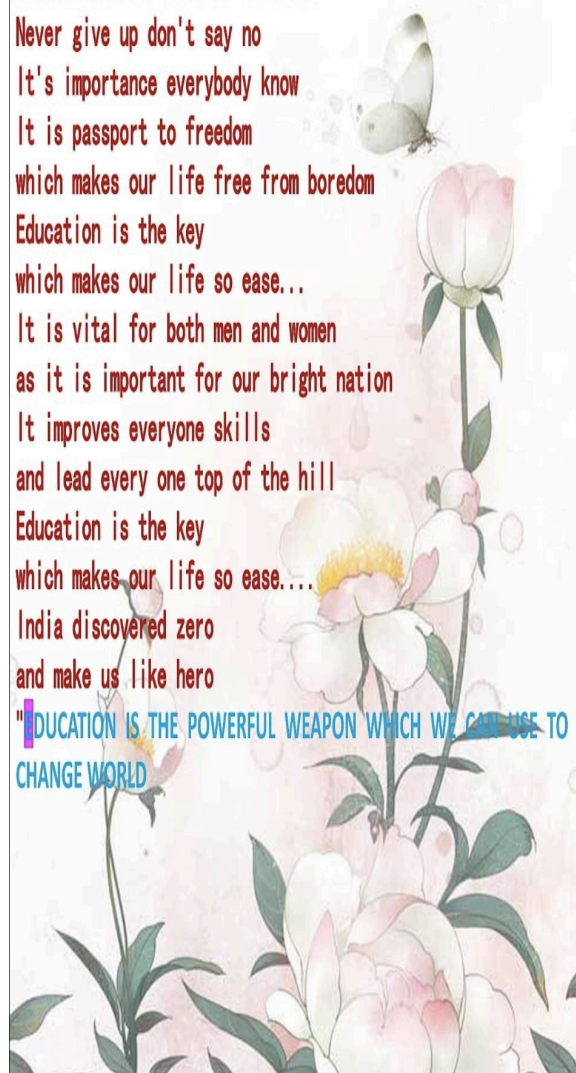
*Blood shattered, lives faded until 1947, Now people living here with comfort as heaven;
